Our helpful staff is available to guide you through your admissions process.

Contact the admissions advisor at the campus of your choice to book a tour, receive program information, sit in on a class and meet the instructor.

Schedule an appointment to take your admissions assessment. You may be excused from the assessment process if in the past three years you have received satisfactory scores on college entrance tests such as the ACT or SAT, Accuplacer, ASSET, COMPASS, TABE. Students who have earned an associate or baccalaureate degree do not need to complete the assessment.

2. Acquire your high school and/or college transcripts

1. Acquire and fill out an application form.

A printable form may be downloaded from witc.edu, and is available at the WITC campus or from your high school counselor's office.

3 Steps to take before you come in for your appointment

3. Brush up on your skills. Review study resources before taking the assessment.

Bring your completed application form, high school/college transcripts and \$30 application fee.

Pay by check, money order, or credit card – Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.

To complete your admissions process, you will meet with a counselor following your assessment to review your program choice and assessment scores.

Interview

Some programs will have additional entrance requirements. Those requirements will be discussed with the counselor during your scheduled interview time after you have completed the admissions assessment.
