

Types of Courses

Technical Studies/Occupational-Specific Courses (Credit)

WITC offers hundreds of career-related courses, workshops, and conferences that can be taken for credit to enhance skills, renew certification, or lead to associate or technical degree program completion. (Some courses have prerequisites.) To advance to higher level courses that have a prerequisite course, a final grade of "C-" or better must be earned in the prerequisite. NOTE: Higher grade requirements are noted on program pages for select courses.

WITC also offers Service Learning and Work-Based Learning options. Service Learning is experiential learning that integrates community service and educational learning objectives. Work-Based Learning opportunities may include: job shadowing, internships, and clinicals, etc.

General Studies Courses (Credit)

The General Studies courses in all of our programs are designed to ensure well-rounded college graduates. These courses include communications, math, social studies, and sciences. (Some courses have prerequisites.)
