

**Health Insurance**

Students should be aware that WITC is not responsible for, and does not have insurance to pay for student, doctor, or hospital bills incurred as a result of accidents or illness while attending college. Since some family health insurance programs terminate when an individual reaches 18 or 22 years of age, a student may wish to purchase individual health insurance to continue protection. WITC has an agreement with a private insurance firm to make health insurance available for students at reasonable rates. Enrollment procedures and a brochure explaining the program are distributed to students during orientation. For written information on the insurance plan, contact the Student Services office. To investigate this program, carefully read the insurance pamphlet and follow the directions. Students are encouraged to carry medical insurance coverage (under their own or a parent's policy).
