Attention Financial Aid Pell Grant recipients: effective for the summer 2010 term, due to changes in federal regulations, you may be eligible for a larger Pell grant than in previous summers. Please see the financial aid advisor for more information.

Attention Financial Aid Applicants: Important Notice Regarding Student Loans. For the 2010-2011 academic year WITC will be switching to the Federal Direct Student Loan Program. All students who receive a student loan will be required to complete a new master promissory note. More details will be included with your award letter and posted on our website.

RETURNING STUDENTS:

- **Complete Your Financial Aid Application** Returning students are encouraged to complete their application for financial aid (FAFSA) before leaving for the summer. Some funding sources are getting low and may not be available for late filers. Remember the fastest and most accurate way to apply for financial aid is over the Internet at www.fafsa.ed.gov. **APPLY TODAY!**
- **Summer Jobs Available** Students who are enrolled in summer courses and are looking for a summer job should contact the financial aid office for details about WITC's summer work-study program. Jobs vary from working in the office to working with our maintenance staff. Stop by the financial aid office for more information.
- **Summer Financial Aid** Thinking about taking a summer class? It takes just three credits to qualify as a half-time student in the summer and financial aid may be available for you. Stop in and talk to Kelly Dunn in the financial aid office to see if you qualify for any aid during the summer.

MY WITC AND FINAL GRADE INFORMATION
