

Graduates Not In the Labor Market

Two hundred and forty (240) of the 1,397 graduates who completed the survey were not available for employment. As indicated in Table VI below, 192 graduates are continuing their education and 20 are unavailable due to family responsibilities. Fourteen



graduates are not in the labor market due to a disability and 14 for “other” reasons. Of the 192 graduates who are continuing their education, 63 graduated from the Rice Lake campus, 57 from New Richmond, 47 from Superior, and 25 from Ashland.
