

Location of Employment

Of the 1,013 graduates who reported their job location, 704 or 70% were employed in the WITC District, 204 or 20% in other states, and 105 or 10% in Wisconsin outside the WITC District. For graduates working in jobs related to their technical training, employment location percentage results were nearly identical with 68% employed in the District, 21% out of state, and 11% in Wisconsin outside the WITC District.

Fifty- seven percent (57%) of Superior graduates and 22% of New Richmond graduates are employed (related) out of state. The percent of graduates employed in Wisconsin but out of the WITC District is lowest for graduates from Superior (3%) compared to 16% for Rice Lake and 11% for Ashland graduates.

Table V below shows employment location for each campus.

The percentage of graduates employed (related) in the District is greatest in Ashland with 82% and Rice Lake with 81% of graduates working in the 11-county area.

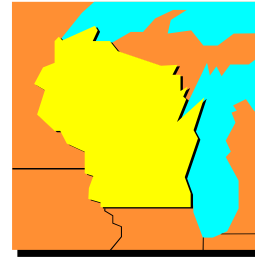
