

## Placement by Instructional Division

The 1,629 2006-2007 graduates represent 52 different programs in six instructional divisions. Table III indicates the number of graduates

and programs in each instructional division and the number of respondents and the response rate obtained for each.

Health and Service graduates represent 64% of all graduates. Business graduates represent 15% and Trade and Technical 14%. The Personal Services division represents 4% of the total graduates and the remaining two divisions (General Education and Agriculture) represent 2% of the total graduates.

The employment status of graduates by instructional division is illustrated on the next page. In the General Studies division 100% of the responding graduates are employed in training-related occupations.

Eighty-nine percent (89%) of graduates in the Agriculture division are employed in training-related occupations. Eighty-three percent (83%) of Personal Services graduates are employed in occupations related to their WITC training. Seventy-six percent (76%) in the Trade and Technical, 67% in Health and Service, and 59% in the Business divisions.

Graduates seeking employment ranged from 11% in the Business division to 9% for Trade and Technical, 7% for Personal Services, and 6% for Health and Service. The Agriculture and General Studies divisions had 100% employment.

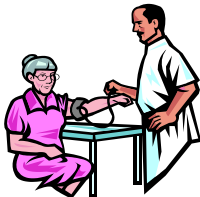
