

# Salary

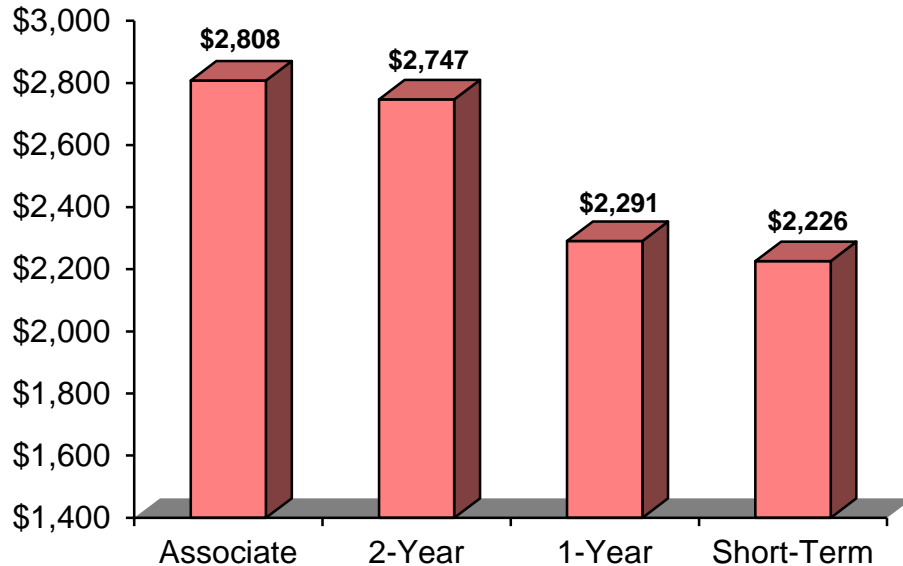
Graduates are asked to provide salary information based on hourly, weekly, monthly, or yearly wages. Regardless of the wage base used, individual responses are converted to a monthly salary and an average monthly wage is reported for each program. These averages are calculated for full-time (35 hours or more per week) employment for training-related jobs and are based on a minimum of three reported salaries.

The average monthly salary for 2006-2007 graduates is \$2,542 or

\$30,507 annually. There is a relationship between the length of training and salary. The average salary for associate degree programs is \$2,808 and two-year technical averaging \$2,747 per month. One-year technical program graduates earn an average of \$2,291 each month and short-term technical certificate graduates earn an average of \$2,226 per month.

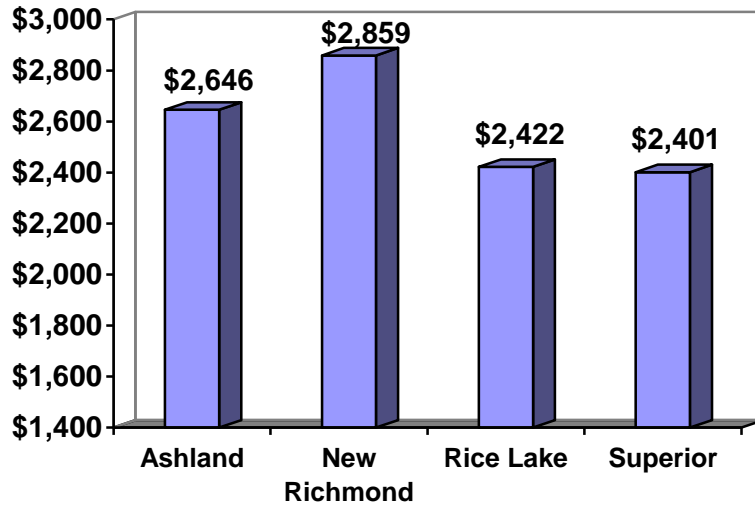
