

Graduates Not In the Labor Market

Two hundred and sixty-three (263) of the 1,427 graduates who completed the survey were not available for employment. As indicated in Table VI below, 220 graduates are continuing their education and 26 are unavailable due to family responsibilities. Twelve



graduates are not in the labor market due to “other” reasons, and 5 are due to disability. Of the 220 graduates who are continuing their education, 80 graduated from the Rice Lake campus, 62 from Superior, 57 from New Richmond, and 21 from Ashland.
