

## Location of Employment

Of the 939 graduates who reported their job location, 618 or 66% were employed in the WITC District, 206 or 22% in other states, and 115 or 12% in Wisconsin outside the WITC District. For graduates working in jobs related to their technical training, employment location percentage results were nearly identical with 66% employed in the District, 20% out of state, and 13% in Wisconsin outside the WITC District.

The percentage of graduates employed (related) in the District is greatest in Rice Lake with 78% and Ashland with 76% of graduates working in the 11-county area.

Fifty-four percent (54%) of Superior graduates and 23% of New Richmond graduates are employed (related) out-of-state. The percent of graduates employed in Wisconsin but out of the WITC District is lowest for graduates from Superior (6%) compared to 18% for Rice Lake and 12% for Ashland and New Richmond graduates.

Appendix F contains a list of the employers and position titles for those graduates who are employed in jobs related to their WITC education.

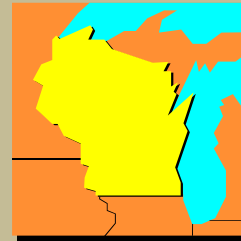
