

Placement by Instructional Division

The 1,697 2007-2008 graduates represent 48 different programs in five instructional divisions. Table III indicates the number of graduates

and programs in each instructional division and the number of respondents and the response rate obtained for each.

Allied Health graduates represent 59% of all graduates. Trade and Technical graduates represent 14% and Business 12%. The Public Safety division represents 10% of the total graduates and the remaining division, Family and Consumer Services, represent 4% of the total graduates.

Seventy-five percent (75%) of graduates in the Public Safety division are employed in training-related occupations. Seventy-one percent (71%) of Family and Consumer Services graduates are

employed in occupations related to their WITC training. Sixty-nine percent (69%) in Business, 67% in Allied Health, and 64% in the Trade and Technical division.

Graduates seeking employment ranged from 17% in the Trade and Technical division to 8% for Business and Allied Health, 6% for Public Safety, and 3% for Family and Consumer Services.

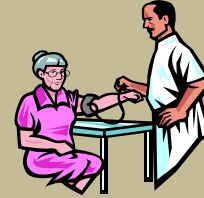
