ADN SEMESTER 4 COURSEWORK AT WITC

All WITC ADN students are required to take all ADN Semester 4 core nursing courses at WITC. These courses include:

- 10543113 Nursing: Complex Health Alterations 2
- 10543114 Nursing: Management and Professional Concepts
- 10543115 Nursing: Advanced Clinical Practice
- 10543116 Nursing: Clinical Transitions

It is not acceptable for students to take any of the ADN Semester 4 courses at any other WTCS school of nursing, although other semesters it is acceptable.

It is acceptable for students to take program required General Studies courses for ADN Semester 4 at other WTCS colleges. This includes 10809196 Introduction to Sociology and the three elective associate degree credits that are included in the ADN program Semester 4 requirements.

This policy has been enacted based on years of data tracking NCLEX-RN passing rates. Students who took ADN Semester 4 coursework at other WTCS schools of nursing had a significantly greater failure rate on the first attempt to pass the NCLEX-RN than students who had taken all ADN Semester 4 coursework at WITC.
