1. Transfer Institution: Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College
Degree: Associate of Applied Science
Programs: (See Attachment #1)

2. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh
Degree: Bachelor of Applied Studies
Program: Organizational Studies emphasis of Leadership & Organizational Studies major

3. Rationale: All of the Bachelor of Applied Studies (BAS) programs are designed specifically to provide leadership skills to students holding an Associate of Applied Science degree from one of the WTCS campuses. The leadership skills and knowledge acquired in the BAS programs complement and add value to the technical skills and knowledge acquired in the WTCS programs.

4. WTCS course/credits accepted in transfer and UW equivalent course/credits: The Undergraduate Credit Transfer Agreement between the University of Wisconsin System and the Wisconsin Technical College System lists the following WTCS courses and their equivalents at UW Oshkosh:

5. Credits from Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College to transfer to UW Oshkosh: See Attachments #2-22.

6. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements that the student must satisfy:

- Earn at least 120 credits.
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
- Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
- Earn at least 35 credits in 300/400 level courses.

Conditions:

- The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Organizational Studies emphasis of the Leadership & Organizational Studies major at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a different emphasis, degree, or major may encounter additional program requirements.
- Students from Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College must have successfully completed one of the Associate of Applied Science degree programs listed in Attachment #1 (fulfilling all coursework stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher, and have graduated in 1990 or later, in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. These terms do **not** apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for an AAS degree.

7. Effective date: July 1, 2015

8. Review date: This agreement will be reviewed in June 2018 and updated or extended at that time.


