STUDENT HANDBOOK

Program Prerequisites

1. Complete application form and submit with fee (fee waiver may apply if previously submitted)
2. Complete Accuplacer entrance assessment to determine placement (waiver may apply with acceptable alternative test scores and/or postsecondary degree completion)
 - a. Minimum Accuplacer Scores:
 - i. Sentence Skills – 81
 - ii. Reading – 67
 - iii. Math – 61
 - b. Students may also submit equivalent scores on the ASSET, COMPASS, TABE or ACT tests. Assessment scores are valid for three years from assessment date. Remediation options are available to reach required scores. See Student Services for more information and equivalent scores.
3. High school diploma or GED certificate; current high school seniors must provide documentation upon graduation
4. Complete one year of high school chemistry or one term of college-level chemistry with a 2.0 or better
5. Computer Literacy assessment (students are expected to have entry-level computer and keyboarding skills)
6. Complete admissions interview with a WITC counselor

Courses that may be taken prior to starting the program are:

1. General Education and Health Science Courses
 - a. Medical Terminology (10501101), Oral Communications (10801196), General Anatomy/Physiology (10806177), English Comp I (10801136), Intro to Diversity Studies (10801195), Intro to Psychology (10809198), Technical Reporting (10801197)
2. One year of high school chemistry or one term of college-level chemistry with a 2.0 or better
