## **PROGRAM COMPLETION**

The health information technology (HIT) program can be completed within two years. Students may, however, choose to complete the program at a part time rate.

Because of course completion variations with incoming students, an HIT academic advisor will work individually with each student to develop a program completion sequence plan.

Program completion sequencing must follow pre/co-requisite requirements, as defined on the HIT curriculum checklist.

Part time sequencing can be sequenced into a 3 or 4 year plan. 4 years is the maximum number of years a student may take to complete the HIT program. At any time a student feels he/she may not meet this requirement, that student should request a meeting with his/her HIT academic advisor.
