Level I & II Fieldwork Exploration Meeting

You will meet with the WITC Academic Fieldwork Coordinator in second semester to discuss fieldwork placements. The intent of this meeting is to discuss fieldwork I and II, your interests, and life situation.

To assist the WITC Academic Fieldwork Coordinator to match students to available fieldwork I and II sites, you are asked to reflect upon your concerns such as geography, life balance, and pace of a work environment. Additionally, please think about the following questions prior to your meeting: What kind of environment facilitates your success, and, what are your interests for future professional practice? These will help the Academic Fieldwork Coordinator understand your interests better.

The OTA Program does not promise/guarantee your placement to any particular site – many factors are considered in the placement of students to the fieldwork sites.

The Academic Fieldwork Coordinator will work hard to find placements. However, remember Fieldwork II placements may be anywhere, including outside of the WITC district and outside of Wisconsin. Level I placements will be within 2 hours of your home campus.
