PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Students enrolled in Health Information Technology program must have a physical examination, required immunizations, required titers, and tuberculin skin test or chest x-ray completed by their healthcare provider. The health form must be submitted to the instructor prior to beginning their professional practice experience (PPE) as directed. Forms for the physical examination are available on the WITC HIT Orientation webpage.

Students are expected to promote and maintain their own optimal level of health. They must assume responsibility for protecting themselves and others from hazards such as infection and radiation. A student's ill health is detrimental to patients and others. Students may not participate if:

- They have a communicable disease.
- There is likelihood of transmission (such as fever, open lesions or weeping dermatitis, skin infection, eye infection, or acute respiratory infection).

Extended absences may result in course failure.
