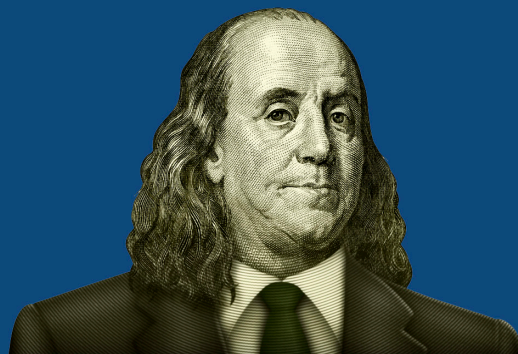

What to Bring

You will need the following items to refer to in order to file your 2020-2021 FAFSA.

If you are a dependent student for financial aid purposes, you will also need these same items for your parent(s). For dependent students, parent(s) are encouraged to attend.

- 2018 Federal Tax Return and W2s
- 2018 Untaxed income returns such as child support, veteran non-education benefits
- Information on savings, retirements, business assets
- Personal email address for student and different email address for parent
- Driver's License
- Social Security Number
- Date of birth
- Month and year of marriage, divorce, widow or separation
