Dental Assistant Clinicals

Health Care Provider CPR must be completed prior to the beginning of Dental Health and Safety class and must be kept current throughout the program.

The purpose of DA Clinical is to provide students with a supervised clinical experience in order to apply the dental assistant skills they have learned. This experience will take place in dental offices within the WITC district and will be supervised by employees of that clinic. The Dental Assistant program instructor(s) will also supervise this experience. Students must complete a minimum of 300 hours of clinical experience.

Students will be assigned to a minimum of two offices (per CODA requirements) that have signed a contract with WITC for these experiences, and will work according to clinic expectations.

Financial reimbursement to a student for any time worked in a clinical setting as a student is not permitted. It is permissible, if the clinical agency so desires, to provide the student with a reward or incentive such as free/reduced meals or parking.

All required academic and skill competencies must be successfully completed prior to starting the DA Clinical experience. Students must also achieve higher than a 79.5% in each program courses prior to the initial site visit for Dental Assistant Clinical.
