The course will prepare you for real-world safe operation of small (multi-rotor and fixed wing) UAV and to provide basic study in preparation for Commercial Remote Pilot Certification under FAR Part 107. Upon completion, you will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the following:

- Certification requirements of the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration CFR Part 107) for commercial operators to legally operate in the US
- The National Airspace Systems (NAS) and the requirements and regulations for operating in this airspace
- Unmanned Aerial Systems (drones) including power systems, radio receivers, transmitters and telemetry
- Caring for, operating and maintaining lithium batteries
- Aircraft loading, weight and balance
- Weather (meteorological) factors as they pertain to UAV operation
