Thank you for this opportunity to provide details and updates regarding the Occupational Therapy Assistant program at WITC that will assist you in your supervision of your level II fieldwork student.

Online Course

Your student will be enrolled in a 2 credit online course, OT Practice and Management (10-514-185) while completing fieldwork II. This course allows students to be at a full time load of 12 credits, which is necessary for many funding sources (financial aid) and insurance requirements. The course provides students the opportunity to apply administrative concepts and procedures to practice. The course also helps students get ready for certification, licensure, and job searching. No assignments in this online course should interfere with your assignments or the projects you want your student to complete.

Student Travel

While every attempt is made to place students in facilities close to their homes and families, this is not always possible. Prior to entry into the program and throughout the program, WITC students are aware that fieldwork II placements may be anywhere, including several hours from their homes. At WITC we ensure that students have a diverse experience, in at least 2 different service delivery models. In order to provide this experience, locations outside of easy driving distance may be required. It is also important to realize while WITC has many contracts with local agencies, local settings may not be available each year based upon staffing, reimbursement constructs or other issues.
