

AGREEMENT

Lakeland College Day Program

To facilitate students' continued growth in higher education, Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) and Lakeland College hereby enter into the following agreement that is subject to renewal every year, coinciding with the publication of the Lakeland College catalog.

This agreement applies only to applicants to the Lakeland College on-campus day program who have received an Early Childhood Education Associate Degree through the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) since June of 2006, and who have attained a final grade point average of at least 3.0 and are interested in completing a Lakeland College Bachelor of Arts degree and teacher certification program in Early Childhood through Middle Childhood Education (PK-6).

1. It is understood that the applicant will follow Lakeland College's application for admission procedures and will be responsible for providing Lakeland with an official transcript from WTCS.
2. Lakeland College will grant to such applicants a transfer of a maximum of 60 semester hours from WCTS to be applied to the requirements of the Bachelor of Arts degree.
3. The applicant agrees to take a minimum of 60 semester hours in an approved course of study directed toward the completion of a major and the general studies requirements.
4. Lakeland College guarantees a minimum renewable annual scholarship of \$5,000.00 to applicants with a minimum 3.0 grade-point-average from WTCS, and who attain a grade-point-average of at least 3.0 at Lakeland College.
5. The applicant will take the Lakeland College mathematics diagnostic test, and agrees to consider the Lakeland College recommendation on placement in an appropriate mathematics course(s) based on the test results. An applicant exempt from the Lakeland College mathematics diagnostic test is one who has a transfer course (or courses) equivalent to Lakeland College's GEN 101 Mathematics Workshop or a higher-level mathematics course or has scored at least in the 40th percentile on the SAT/ACT.
6. It is understood that the applicant will enter Lakeland College at junior standing and is, therefore, is exempt from Lakeland College's Basic Skills Reading Requirement.

7. The applicant will take the Lakeland College writing diagnostic test, and agrees to consider Lakeland College's recommendation on placement in appropriate writing course(s) based on the applicant's performance on the writing diagnostic. An applicant exempt from the Lakeland College writing diagnostic test is one who has a transfer course (or courses) equivalent to Lakeland College's GEN 100 Writing Workshop or a higher-level writing course (WTCS students who have completed WTCS 801-195 Written Communications are exempt from writing diagnostic test) or an ACT English score of at least 17.


8. Lakeland College warrants graduation no more than two and one-half years after entry, contingent upon the following:
 - a. Successful completion of at least fifteen semester hours each fall and spring term and three semester hours during May Term; and
 - b. Maintenance of at least a 3.0 grade point average;
 - c. Successful completion of the Elementary Education major requirements;
 - d. Successful completion of the General Studies requirements; and
 - e. Successful completion of a minimum total of 120 semester hours.
