1. Since WITC has 4 campuses, I can apply to how many campuses if I want to be in the ADN program?
 - I am only allowed to apply to one WITC campus for the ADN program
 - I can apply to no more than 2 WITC campuses for the ADN program
 - I can apply to as many WITC campuses as I like—it doesn't matter

2. Once I have submitted my general WITC Application for Admission how many days do I have to complete *STEP 1* of the ADN Admission Process?
