1. If courses have been substituted for those specified in the program at Wisconsin Technical College System, they would be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they apply to the degree at UW-Stout.
2. Elective courses taken at Wisconsin Technical College System for the program will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they apply to the degree at UW-Stout.
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 is required for admission. However, courses which have been completed with a grade of D are acceptable to meet program requirements unless the UW-Stout major requires a higher acceptable grade.
4. The UW-Stout baccalaureate candidate must also meet UW-Stout's General Education, Ethnic Studies, and Global Perspective requirements in order to graduate from UW-Stout with a B.S. in Human Development & Family Studies.
5. The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Human Development & Family Studies program that pertains to this agreement.
6. In completing a degree in Human Development & Family Studies at UW-Stout, students transferring from Wisconsin Technical College System will have to complete the following requirements:
